

**THE BOROUGH OF READING (SCHOOL STREET)
(GREAT KNOLLYS STREET) (CIVITAS ACADEMY)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (EXPERIMENTAL)
ORDER 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Reading Borough Council on 12 June 2024 made an Experimental Order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”). The effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle, except eligible vehicles as agreed by Reading Borough Council, to enter or proceed along Great Knollys Street between its junction with Bedford Road and eastwards adjacent to Civitas Academy and up to the end of this section where there is an existing traffic restriction.

The Order will come into operation Monday 24 June 2024 between the hours of 8.30am to 9.00am and 2.55pm to 3.40pm, Monday to Friday term time only.

A copy of the Experimental Order, this Notice, plans showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council’s reasons for making the Order, may be inspected online at <http://consult.reading.gov.uk> or by appointment only at the Civic office, Bridge Street between 10am and 4pm Monday to Friday.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Anyone wishing to support or object to the making of the Experimental Order indefinite may do so, within a period of six months from 24 June 2024, (or, if the order is varied by another order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, from the date that variation order or modification or the latest variation or modification comes into force), by e-mailing transport@reading.gov.uk or writing to Strategic Transport Reading Borough Council, Civic Offices, Bridge Street, Reading RG1 2LU stating the grounds on which they are made quoting reference: Civitas Academy School Street.

Further, if any person wishes to question the validity of the Experimental Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

Please note that all objections received may be considered in public by the Council and the name and addresses of the persons making it could become available for public inspection.
