

**THE BOROUGH OF READING**  
**(SWAINSTONE ROAD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES)**  
**ORDER 20\*\***

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 32, 35, 49, 53, 122(1) and 122(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act as amended proposes to make the above Order.

The general nature and effect of the Order will be to designate free and paid for on street parking places and introduce waiting, loading and stopping restrictions as specified in the schedules below:

**SCHEDULE 1: NO WAITING AT ANY TIME**

**Swainstone Road, North and South Sides**

From its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 10 metres west of that junction

**Swainstone Road, North Side**

From a point 30 metres west of its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 35 metres west of that junction

**Swainstone Road, South Side**

From a point 29 metres west of its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 33 metres west of that junction

**Swainstone Road, North and South Sides**

From its western end to a point 9m east of that end

**SCHEDULE 2: SHARED USE 8.00AM-8.00PM PERMIT HOLDERS OR WAITING LIMITED TO 2 HOURS NO RETURN WITHIN 2 HOURS, AT OTHER TIMES PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY**

**Swainstone Road, North Side**

From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 30 metres west of that junction

**Swainstone Road, South Side**

From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 29 metres west of that junction

**SCHEDULE 3: RESIDENT PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY – MONDAY TO SUNDAY**

**Swainstone Road, North Side**

From a point 35 metres west of its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 9 metres east of the western end of Swainstone Road

**Swainstone Road, South Side**

From a point 33 metres west of its junction with Basingstoke Road to a point 9 metres east of the western end of Swainstone Road

**SCHEDULE 4: ADDRESSES FOR ISSUE OF RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS PARKING PERMITS**

**Zone 10R**

1-69 Swainstone Road

Please note that in accordance with the current Freedom of Information legislation, the Council may publish and/or disclose the entire content of any correspondence (including letter, forms or emails) sent in response to this Notice and such responses may be subject to public scrutiny.

As previously stated in press releases, any existing signs related to the above restrictions are not currently being enforced. The outcome of this consultation will be the sole determining factor in deciding whether these signs are retained or removed. The presence of current signage does not imply any predetermined outcome and all responses will be considered impartially to ensure a fair and unbiased decision making process.
