

**THE BOROUGH OF READING
(LONDON ROAD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES)
ORDER 20****

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 32, 35, 49, 53, 122(1) and 122(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act as amended proposes to make the above Order.

The general nature and effect of the Order will be to designate free and paid for on street parking places and introduce waiting, loading and parking restrictions as specified in the schedules below:

Schedule 1: No Waiting At Any Time and No Loading At Any Time

London Road, north side: From its junction with London Street to a point 34m west of its junction with East Street.

London Road, north side: From a point 4m west of its junction with East Street to a point 4m east of that junction.

London Road, north side: From a point 14m east of its junction with East Street to its junction with Kings Road.

London Road, both sides: From its junction with Amity Road to the Borough Boundary.

London Road, south side: From its junction with Silver Street to a point 35m east of its junction with De Beauvoir Road.

Schedule 2: Monday to Saturday, 8am-6.30pm, Waiting Limited to 30mins, No Return Within 30mins

London Road, south side: From a point 35m east of its junction with De Beauvoir Road to a point 60m east of that junction.

Schedule 3: Permit Holders Only (24 Hours a day Monday to Sunday)

London Road, north side: from a point 4m west of the junction with East Street to a point 34m west of that junction.

London Road, north side: from a point 4m east of the junction with East Street to a point 14m east of that junction.

All objections and other representations to the proposed order must be made in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made and must be sent to arrive before by no later than 28 March 2025. Objections received after this date may not be considered.

Please note that in accordance with the current Freedom of Information legislation, the Council may publish and/or disclose the entire content of any correspondence (including letter, forms or emails) sent in response to this Notice and such responses may be subject to public scrutiny.

As previously stated in press releases, any existing signs related to the above restrictions are not currently being enforced. The outcome of this consultation will be the sole determining factor in deciding whether these signs are retained or removed. The presence of current signage does not imply any predetermined outcome and all responses will be considered impartially to ensure a fair and unbiased decision making process.
