

THE BOROUGH OF READING
(A33 / ROSE KILN LANE) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025

The Reading Borough Council has made a speed limit order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to impose a 30mph speed limit along the entire lengths of the following lengths of roads and will come into operation on 5 December 2025.

A33, both directions

Between a point approximately 30 metres north of the Berkeley Avenue overbridge and to a point approximately 130 metres south of 29 Rose Kiln Lane in both directions.

Rose Kiln Lane, both directions

Rose Kiln Lane for its entire length in both directions between its junction with Berkeley Avenue to junction with A33.

When the proposal for this Order was advertised on 14 March 2024, it was referred to as the “A33 Rose Kiln Lane) (30 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2024” for consultation purposes. The Order has now been made in 2025 and is correctly titled the “A33 / Rose Kiln Lane) (30 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2025.” This amendment relates only to the title of the Order; the provisions and effect of the Order remain as previously advertised.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from 27 November 2025 apply for the purpose to the High Court.
